Unit	End of unit target
Unit A – Creation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that there are two stories of Creation in the Book of Genesis. • Understand what being made in the image and likeness of God means and the responsibility to use our God given talents. • Know some reasons for praising God the creator of the world.
Unit B – Miracles & the Sacrament of the Sick	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know a number of miracles of Jesus and identify how his actions brought change to people's lives. • Know about some places of pilgrimage and prayer for the sick. • Understand that the Sacrament of the Sick is an important celebration for those who are ill.
Unit C – Advent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know and understand that Christians prepare to remember the first Coming of Christ and prepare for his Second Coming during Advent. • Know and discuss the messages of those who have proclaimed the coming of Christ.
Unit D – Christmas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know the main features of the Christmas Story and understand some of the difficulties faced by the different characters in the story.
Unit E – Baptism	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reference Gospel accounts of the Baptism of Jesus. • Describe, sequence and explain many of the signs, symbols and actions in the Sacrament of Baptism.
Unit F – Parables & sayings of Jesus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know some important Parables and Sayings of Jesus. • Understand the Kingdom of God was part of the language Jesus used to explain his preaching about welcoming and accepting God's presence through him. • Think of some ways in which the Church lives out this teaching of Jesus.
Unit G – Lent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that Lent is a Season of Change for Christians to become more like Christ. • Understand some things that damage human relationships and the consequences of giving in to temptations that are wrong. • Recognise that the Sacrament of Reconciliation is the Church's celebration of God's forgiveness of sin.
Unit H – Holy Week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know many of the events of the last week of Jesus' life. • Understand the reasons why some people wanted to kill Jesus. • Know the story of the Passover and recognise key links between this story, the Last Supper, and the celebration of Mass.
Unit I – Easter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that the Easter Vigil is the Church Celebration of the Resurrection of Christ. • Know the structure of the Vigil and understand the meaning attached to some of the symbols used during the Vigil. • Discuss the importance of Christian belief in eternal life.
Unit J – Pentecost	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know about the transformation of the Apostles of Jesus through the gift of the Holy Spirit. • Know that the Holy Spirit is included in the Church's belief in the Holy Trinity. • Discuss some of the qualities of the Holy Spirit.
Unit K – The work of the Apostles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a knowledge of the work of the Apostles after Pentecost. • Understand some reasons why they were so keen to proclaim the Resurrection of Christ to the world.
Unit L – Marriage & Holy Orders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that Marriage and Holy Orders are Sacraments of Commitment. • Recall the promises made in Marriage and key tasks of the Archbishop, Priests and deacons. • Explain the meaning of the Body of Christ as a term for roles and responsibilities in the Church.
